Training Content CA-TS 2.02

Publication: 8th Edition\Canadian

Issue: Revised Standard, Added Related Standard

Effective Date: April 1, 2008

Discussion: Based on research and response from the field, this Standard has been revised and a Related Standard added. This Standards Update applies to all organisations whose Accreditation Agreement has been received by COA on or following April 1, 2008. For all other organisations, this Standards Update is optional.

Revised Standard

CA-TS 2.02

All personnel who have regular contact with clients receive training on legal issues, including:

- a. **identifying and** reporting suspected abuse and neglect **of a child**, as applicable;
- b. **federal and provincial laws requiring limits to confidentiality, including response to a subpoena;**
- c. **duty to warn;**
- d. the organisation's policies and procedures on privacy and confidentiality, and penalties for violation of these policies and procedures; and
- e. the legal rights of service recipients.



Original Standard

CA-TS 2.02

All personnel who have regular contact with clients receive training on legal issues, including:

- a. ~~mandatory, legal reporting and the identification of clinical indicators of suspected abuse and neglect, as applicable;~~
- b. ~~reportable criminal behavior;~~
- c. the organisation's policies and procedures on privacy and confidentiality, and penalties for violation of these policies and procedures; and
- d. the legal rights of service recipients.
